President Kreis opened the meeting and Ernie offered devotions on the 1873 backstory of the hymn *It Is Well With My Soul,* the truth of a family's faith rising above tragedies and sorrows. There were no congregational comments or discussion.

Minutes – March minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report – Receipts exceeded expenses for a positive balance at month end. Report was approved as presented.

Pastor's Report: He was very pleased with the mid-week, holy week, and Easter services.

He made five home visits, including one home communion and offered communion at Stone Hearth on March 25 and April 8.

New members being received soon include Mary Bell, Tom Gosinski, the Erb family, and Kennedy Tucker. Kristine Dalrymple will be received by transfer.

He will preside at Marla Weber's funeral at Zion Lutheran on April 20, attend the Guided Retreat at St. Benedict Center in Schuyler April 21 – 28. Baccalaureate Service for the Class of 2024 will be May 1 at the Sun Theater and ALC Senior

Recognition will be May 19.

We will host a guest speaker on August 25 to speak on the *Food for the Poor* program.

Evangelism: They've agreed to change the committee's name to 'Outreach and Hospitality', feeling it's more representative of their mission. They will distribute popsicles at the elementary track meet and possibly sponsor a movie in the summer. They will also contact new folks in town, have prepared new folders for home communion servers and added households to the list.

Youth & Family: Twelve students will be recognized on Senior Sunday, May 19. Brunch will be served after worship that day. Preparations continue for the National Youth Gathering but they've not heard from the Foundation as to what they will contribute to the cost. Usually they pay for the sponsors, which this year are Cressy Rossell, Lonna Grabenstein who is bringing the Eustis group, and Cathy Sabin who will go with her family.

Music & Worship: New members Nancy Jobman and Steve Berke were welcomed to the committee.

Discussion was had on the Lent and Easter services / meals and possible improvements for next year. Thanks to United Methodist for inviting us to their Good Friday service and to Colbie Brown for singing. The brass and woodwinds were also a wonderful addition to Easter worship.

Thanks also to Carol Wahlgren, Coleen Clark, and Charlie and Connie Bihlmaier tor repairing and organizing the choir robes.

A pipe on the organ is collapsing and will need to be replaced. A matching white parament for the pulpit costs \$550. Amanda will check on available memorial funds.

Chuck Titkemeier's memorial service will be June 29 at 11:00 a.m.

Property: There is a summer mowing sign-up sheet on the welcome stand and there's already been some volunteers.

Glenn has established an account at the new ACE Hardware store.

The City will repair, at no cost, the sidewalk in the back when they're working on sidewalks this summer.

Bids have been received From CMH Interiors and 5-Star Flooring for the youth room and hallway project. CMH was \$500 less for the youth room at \$5500 and Tom Gosinski will provide the paint. Glenn also received information from Mission Investment Funds regarding loans on projects in excess of \$100,000. This could be used to replace whatever we wanted, such as HVAC, windows in the educational wing, etc. Following discussion, Council was not interested in taking on debt at this time. Amanda moved and Ernie seconded to move forward with the renovation of the youth room into a space to be used as bereavement, bridal, and a meeting area for such as Parent / Child Center. All present voted "Yea" and the motion carried.

Amanda moved to approve the \$5500 bid from CMH Interiors for materials and labor for new flooring in the youth room. Glenn seconded the motion and all present voted "Yea". The motion carried. Kara will contact Kelly Schmeeckle about using Arlene Peterson's memorial donations for this project. She will also contact Tom to proceed with the ceiling. Ernie talked with Lori Kitzing regarding items stored in the west room by the youth room. She is okay with moving those items elsewhere but would rather not have them upstairs.

Franzen's are still waiting on the new lighting equipment for the sanctuary.

Discussion items:


- Discussed putting a security camera in the office but we need to complete updating the system before that can be done.
 - Discussed having contracts for outside groups to use the building.
 - Pastor reported new (acolyte) candle lighters will cost \$125 \$135 each. Further discussion will be had in May.

Since Ken Christensen's term is up, Glenn moved, Lori seconded, to remove Ken Christiansen from the Foundation account at Dayspring Bank and add Brooke Stevens. All present voted "Yea" and the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer.





